The Embassy of Bangladesh, Tokyo celebrated the Opening Ceremony of Padma Bridge today (25 June 2022) with due fervor and festivity. With a view to observing the event in a befitting manner, the Embassy organized a "Celebration of Padma Bridge Opening" program at the Bangabandhu hall of Bangladesh Embassy, Tokyo.
